Paul's First Journey //

Episode 5: Church of the Poisoned Mind

ACTS 14:1-7

At Iconium Paul and Barnabas went as usual into the Jewish synagogue. There they spoke so effectively that a great number of Jews and Greeks believed. ² But the Jews who refused to believe stirred up the other Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the brothers. ³ So Paul and Barnabas spent considerable time there, speaking boldly for the Lord, who confirmed the message of his grace by enabling them to perform signs and wonders. ⁴ The people of the city were divided; some sided with the Jews, others with the apostles. ⁵ There was a plot afoot among both Gentiles and Jews, together with their leaders, to mistreat them and stone them. ⁶ But they found out about it and fled to the Lycaonian cities of Lystra and Derbe and to the surrounding country, ⁷ where they continued to preach the gospel

Sermon Notes

GROWTH MODE- The church is in growth mode due to the bold proclamation of God's Word.

Vs. 1 At Iconium Paul and Barnabas went as usual into the Jewish synagogue. There **they spoke** so effectively that a great number of Jews and Greeks believed.

Bold Proclamation— Act 4:31 After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

How will they know— Romans 10:13-15 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."¹⁴ How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Loss for words— Luke 12:12 "When you are brought before synagogues, rulers and authorities, do not worry about how you will defend yourselves or what you will say, ¹² for the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say."

PUSHBACK— Newton's Third Law of Motion states that for every action, there is an equal and opposite reaction.

Vs. 2 But the Jews who refused to believe stirred up the other Gentiles and **poisoned their "minds"** against the brothers.

"Minds" Greek Word= PSUCHAS—the soul as the seat of affections and will.

RESPONSE TO THE PUSHBACK—Vs. 3 So Paul and Barnabas spent considerable time there, speaking boldly for the Lord who confirmed the message of his grace by enabling them to perform signs and wonders.

Paul responds to the pushback by pushing back.

Signs and wonders followed the preaching of the word.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

How do you "proclaim" the gospel in your own life? Are you more passive or bold in how you do this?

Share an experience where you have shared the message of Jesus with someone. What was their reaction?

How is the world poisoning the minds of people against the message of Jesus?

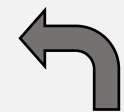
